#### **JUDGE: FRED DEWSBURY, ONTARIO, CANADA**

I am a retired science teacher who has been associated with purebred dogs almost my entire life. An uncle was a well-known breeder of bulldogs and borzoi.

In 1970 a particular puppy claimed me for his own, and became an important part of the family.

He was shown successfully and became founding stock for Duchenka kennels. That dog won the first ever borzoi specialty in Canada, in 1975.

Over a span of 20 plus years my wife and I bred a number of champions, group winners, specialty winners and best in show dogs

I also had Italian greyhounds, and handled dogs from all seven groups

I earned my first judging licence in 1987 and achieved all-breed status in 2001. Judging has taken me across Canada and the USA, Europe, Scandinavia, Ireland, South and Central America. I have also officiated in Australia and New Zealand, China, Thailand, South Korea, Indonesia and the Philippines.

Over the years I have served on the executives of several all-breed dog clubs and for a term on the Dog Show Council of the CKC.

# 2023 JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES CONFORMATION JUDGES

# CAROLYN CEDERMAN, NEW ZEALAND LANASCOL IRISH SETTERS

I started my involvement in the dog world with my first Irish Setter in 1973. I have continued to breed and successfully show Irish Setters for the past 50 years under the Lanascol prefix.

To date I have bred and shown eight NZ Grand Champions. I have also bred 3 Supreme Champions. In 2012 Supreme Champion Lanascol Question Answered achieved the award of #1 Show Dog of All Breeds in New Zealand.

Over the years I have also imported a number of Irish Setters to help with my breeding program. For 15 years I was involved with breeding and exhibiting Labrador Retrievers alongside the Irish Setters. I have also owned and exhibited 2 American Cockers. For the past 26 years I have also been involved with breeding and exhibiting Pointers with my husband, Paul Robinson.

In the 70's I was on the All-Breed's committee in the Manawatu. I served on the Irish Setter Committee commencing in 1979, initially as the Treasurer and then as President. I was honoured to be awarded life membership of this club in 2016. I am on the Waitemata Gundog Club Committee as Treasurer and I was made a life member of this club in 2014. I am currently in my 5th year as the Chairman of the Auckland Judges Association. I have been judging since 1985 and achieved my All Breeds judging status in 2010.

I have had many judging appointments in New Zealand including the NZ National Dog Show in 2003. I have judged in Victoria, New South Wales, Canberra, South Australia, Queensland, Western Australia, Israel, Ireland, Canada, the United States and Sweden where I judged part of the Working Group and the Gundog breeds. I have been appointed to judge Irish Setters in the UK in September 2023 (changed from 2020 due to Covid) at the City of Birmingham Championship show. I have judged all of my Groups and Best in Show as well as specialty shows in the USA on several occasions. I have judged all Groups and Best in Show in New Zealand, United States, India, Australia, Canada and also in China.

# ANNA M. HEWSON, CANADA THUNDERUN KENNELS

My first purebred dog was an Irish Setter in the 70's. Our family fostered a Siberian Husky for Canine Vision Canada who became certified and is recognized as the first Siberian Husky to be a Guide for the blind.

My involvement evolved into exhibiting Siberians in 1985 and establishing "ThundeRun" prefix in 1988. My first litter, a Siberian litter arrived in July 1990, which resulted in 2, owner handled Champions.

Now retired from the life of farming, pedigreed seed grains and Clydesdale horses. We had a select herd of approximately 45 horses—all of which were homegrown. The majority were brood mares that produced 6 to 10 exciting youngsters each year; some of which we would exhibit in Fall Fairs throughout Southern Ontario including the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair in Toronto. We entered horses in conformation line classes and also teams up to a six-horse hitch...breeder, owner handled, trained and driven. There was a Hewson horse at every Royal until 2005.

I became involved in Australian Shepherds in 1998, and have owned a Rough Collie, Newfoundland, Portuguese Water Dog and a Pointer. I am no longer breeding; I co-own Irish Setters.

I have served in numerous positions, both elected and volunteer in Siberians, Australian Shepherds, all breed clubs and Clydesdale Horse Associations at both National and Provincial levels.

I began judging in 2009 and have had the pleasure of judging the B.C. Siberian Husky Club Specialty, the Canadian National Australian Shepherd Association Specialty, the Maritime Herding Group Specialty, Alaskan Malamute Club of Canada Specialty, Australian Shepherd Club of America shows as well as in the U.S.A. eastern states.

I am licensed for Sporting, Hound, Working, Toys, Non-Sporting and Herding, I am on permit for Terriers.

Apart from my dog hobby, I am kept busy as chief cheer leader at sport events of our nine grandchildren.

# FRANK KANE, UNITED KINGDOM HIRONTOWER COCKERS

Frank Kane had his first dog, an English Cocker Spaniel in 1960, as a schoolboy and has been involved with that breed ever since. He was fortunate to be part of the golden age in that breed in the UK when the breed had many successful influential kennels. He has judged the breed at the Centenary Show of the Cocker Club in the UK, Crufts and the American Spaniel Club. In 1970 he bought two American cocker bitches and these were the foundation of his HIRONTOWER kennel – producing 13 champions and several group winners in the UK with other champions in several countries.

Frank also owned two champion Sealyham Terriers and showed Beagles, whilst his long-time partner bred a string of champion Great Danes and owned top winning Afghans.

Frank is approved to judge all groups and BIS in the UK. He judged Best in Show at Crufts in 2012. He has judged five groups at Crufts and at Westminster 2023 he is to judge the Sporting Group. He has judged Best in Show at two of the Royal Shows in Australia and Best in Show at prestigious shows in many countries.

Frank Kane is author and co-author of several books and has been a regular contributor to the Canine Press. He has been Chairman of the Breed Standards at the UK Kennel Club for almost 20 years, and for many years Frank has been part of the television commentary team for Crufts dog show.

Outside of his canine passion, Frank has maintained his interest in horses and ponies since childhood with a special delight in children's riding ponies, hacks and hunters.

# ADRIAN LANDARTE, URUGUAY EL RETORNO KENNELS

I have been living with dogs pure bred or not, all my life. I started in the world of dog shows at age of 17, when I bought my first Afghan Hound. From that moment I got involved more and more in this hobby as breeder, exhibitor, judge, organizer, and director.

I am currently President of FCI Judges' commission, Vice-President of the Americas and Caribbean FCI Section, President of the Kennel Club Uruguayo, and was president of the Cimarron Uruguayo Club, Irish Setter Club of Uruguay and KCU welfare commission, and member of the FCI Show Commission.

With Jorge Nallem we founded El Retorno Kennels and have had great success breeding Irish Setters, Beagles, Schnauzers, Dachshund, Fox Terriers, Whippets, Greyhounds and Cimarron Uruguayo.

We have achieved more than 160 All Breed BISs, including FCI A&C section shows, Sicalam, WDS Circuit, BISS FTW US National, BIG at WDS and FCI Section Shows, several world CH titles, and several top dog of the year all breed in 4 different countries.

I am an all-breed judge and began my career as an Irish Setter judge in 1987. I have had the pleasure to judge and meet friends in more than 50 countries throughout the world and I am very glad and honoured to judge at the Erie Shores Kennel Club show in 2023.

# DAVID R. MILLER, U.S. SHANDELL SALUKIS

Mr. David R. Miller (aka Jean-David Laplanche) has been a dog enthusiast all his life. From an early age, his parents raised various terriers. In the early seventies, while residing in France, he fixed his sights upon the dogs that he had raised for over forty years—Salukis. Under the prefix of Shandell, and coupled with the French Saluki kennel, Arab Bahari, he still occasionally breeds and shows. In addition, he has owned Afghans, Dalmatians and Italian Greyhounds.

In the Mid-Seventies and throughout the Eighties, Mr. Miller showed not only his Salukis, but dogs in several breeds for clients. In 1988, he applied to the American Kennel Club and was approved to judge Salukis. Since then, he has been approved to judge the American Kennel Club Sporting Group, Hound Group, Toy Group, Non-Sporting Group, Fourteen Terriers, Five Herding and Three Working breeds.

# PAUL ROBINSON, NEW ZEALAND ROBWYN POINTERS

I have bred, owned, and shown pointers since 1980. When I was a boy, I first came to know the Pointer as my father owned a Pointer as a hunting dog. We would frequently spend a day out shooting together. I acquired my first show Pointer in 1980 and since that time have had a close association with the Breed.

I have bred and owned many wonderful Pointers and have bred or owned fifteen different All Breeds Best in Show winning Pointers (79 BIS wins) including the BIS at the only Pointer National to be held in Australia which occurred in 1988. I co-bred the BIS winner of the New Zealand National Dog Show in 2005 with this dog going on to win BOB and Group 3 at Cruft's in the UK. He also won BIS at National Gundog in the UK in 2008. During his UK campaign he gained 20 CC's. I bred both the father and mother of the #1 dog of All Breeds in NZ Dogzonline in 2010 and bred and handled the BOB winning Pointer at Crufts in 2012, with this dog going on to take Group 4. This Pointer is the only dog in the breed's history to hold Grand Champion status in both NZ and Australia and Sh Ch status in the UK. In 2019 I campaigned Supreme Champion Kanix Mario at Robwyn (Imp-UK) to #1 show dog of all breeds in New Zealand. I have spent many years as an active field trial enthusiast and was a regular competitor at field trail events when I lived in Queensland, Australia.

I began my judging career in Queensland in 1987. Whilst living in Queensland, Australia, I sat and passed examinations to judge Gundogs, Toys, and Hounds. I returned to New Zealand from Australia in 1996 and sat and passed my New Zealand Gundog Championship license in 2006 after 19 years of judging experience.

I am licensed to judge all Gundog Breeds and all Hound breeds. ### Entry Information

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. Entries close 8 P.M. (ET) Wednesday, May 10, 2023, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
- 6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

### General Information

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Erie Shores Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
- 6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Will be 30 feet from the rings and the official areas.

## Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

#### TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
- By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.

**Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN.** However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

### Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$64 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

# Non-Member Participation Fee

#### Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup>includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <a href="SHALL NOT">SHALL NOT</a> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

**Section 15.1.11** A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

# GCH and Grand Champion Points

**Section 15.2.1** The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

**15.2.2** Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

**Section 15.2.3** To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### **Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)**

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

#### **Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)**

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

### GCHEX and Grand Champion Excellent Points

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

**Section 15.3.2** To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

**Section 15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

# Altered Champion and Altered Points

**Section 13.8.1** Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

# Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

**Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

# Moving Class Dog to Specials Only

**Section 8.9** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

### NEW – Moving Back to the Classes

**Section 8.10.5** A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.



### **HEALTH REMINDERS**

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

#### **Limited Entry**

**OBEDIENCE:** Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

**RALLY:** Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 10 dogs per hour less time for walkthroughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

## Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds

These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.

Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

### **Moving Up**

6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

6.9.3 The Trial Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.

6.9.5 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

#### **Bitches in Season**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

#### **Class Structure (Age & Obedience Class Requirements)**

#### (A) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

#### (B) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

#### (C) SENIOR OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

#### (D) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to com-pete in this class.

#### (E) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

#### (F) SENIOR OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

#### (G) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday.

#### (H) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday.

#### (I) SENIOR OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday.

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the trial.

Any dog may be used at the Pre-Novice, or Novice level including those with any Obedience titles. A dog used at the Open level must have a CD title (either CKC and/or AKC).

Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler.

## Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN), a PEN or a CCN number.

**Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN.** However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

# Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

## Performance Event Number (PEN)

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a **CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED** to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:

- The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (not on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List).
- The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- The dog must be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

# Canine Companion Number (CCN)

**Unrecognized Breeds** 

A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows **UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS** to compete in CKC performance events. To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:

- The dog must be either an Unrecognized Breed.
- Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit an application online); or
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.

## Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

**Section 19.7** of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

## Master Obedience Trial Champion (MOTCH)

**Section 14.3.1** The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

**Section 14.3.2** Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.

**Section 14.3.3** Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits toward both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.

**Section 14.3.4** One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.

**Section 14.3.5** A dog must acquire a total of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.

### Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

# Rally Champion (RCH)

**Section 16.1** The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

**Section 16.2** A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.

**Section 16.3** The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.

- (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
- (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
