2026 JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES

CONFORMATION JUDGES

CHRISTOPHE COPPEL, FRANCE

My mother was a breeder of whippets when I was a child. I followed her to every show and to every racing meet. So, she gave me the virus very early (1979). I had to wait until the end of my studies to have my own whippets. In 1988, DIXMOOR kennels was born and I bought my own first whippet. Then several litters were born at home and some of my dogs did really in the showrings in France and abroad.

I decided to become a judge in 2003. Of course, my first breed was the Whippet. Then I decided to apply for other breeds. According to the rules of the French Kennel Club, I had to judge all the breeds in group 10 before applying for other breeds in other groups.

Now I am approved to judge all breeds in groups 10, 5 and 3, and some breeds group 9. I have had the opportunity to judge in many countries at all breed shows: Sweden, Finland, Norway, Denmark, Italy, Belgium, The Netherlands, Germany, Ireland, England (only whippets), Bahrein, Hungary, Czech Republic, Austria, Poland, Slovenia, Switzerland, Spain, Portugal, USA and Australia. I also had the great honor to judge some sighthounds at the World Dog Show in Paris in 2011 and at the World Dog Show in Milano in 2015.

DANIK DANCAUSE, QUÉBEC, CANADA

I began showing dogs in 1989 at the age of sixteen, marking the start of a lifelong passion for the sport. Best known as a former professional handler, I had the privilege of showing over forty breeds to championships and as specials in both Canada and the United States.

I have also been closely associated with Portuguese Water Dogs since the mid-1990s, as a handler, owner, and breeder. Throughout my adult life, I have owned, shown, and campaigned multiple Pointers, which have remained a significant part of my involvement in the sport.

I have been a licensed dog judge with the Canadian Kennel Club for almost ten years and am approved to judge the Working, Herding, and Sporting Groups. I am currently on permit for the second half of the Non-Sporting Group. Since beginning my judging career, I have had the opportunity to officiate at all-breed shows and independent specialties on both sides of the border. Most recently, I had the honour of judging the Sporting Group at the prestigious National Dog Show of the Kennel Club of Philadelphia.

I would like to wish all exhibitors the best of luck and look forward to seeing your dogs in the ring.

PAULINE GRUTZNER, AUSTRALIA

I attended my first dog show in 1969 with my beagle and immediately fell in love with the Sport. Over the next eleven years I bred and showed a number of beagles to their titles.

I purchased my first American Cocker Spaniel in 1980 beginning a 45-year love affair with the breed under the Sunfire prefix. These were joined by Sussex spaniels in 1999 and then the Schipperkes arrived in 2014. I have imported 15 dogs from the USA, UK, Europe and New Zealand and have bred over 90 champions in the three breeds including Supreme Champions, Grand Champions (Australia and New Zealand), Multi Best in Show and Specialty winners. In 2012 I was the Number One Gundog (Sporting) breeder and I also bred the Number One Gundog.

I am a life member of the American Cocker Spaniel Club of Victoria, the current President of Greensborough and District Kennel club and have just stepped down after 9 years on the Dogs of Victoria Management Committee.

I gained my Gundog licence in 2001 followed by hounds in 2003 and gaining my All Breed licence in 2019. I have judged Gundog specialties in three states of Australia and New Zealand as well as English Cocker and Hungarian Vizsla specialties.

I have judged in all States of Australia, both islands of New Zealand, South Africa and the United States of America. This is my first visit to Canada judging and I would like to thank Erie Shores Kennel Club for this opportunity

MARIE HOGARTY, IRELAND

My love of dogs started as a child when I owned a Smooth Haired Miniature Dachshund and Labradors as pets. My first show dog was with a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel and that is where my love of dog shows began.

As an adult I showed a German Shepherd a few times who unfortunately got cancer and died. I also handled Elkhounds and Cavaliers. I got a Cairn Terrier in the late 80's, and I have bred two Cairns that have won BOB at Crufts and a third who won the CC. I also bred the only Cairn to go Best in Show at an All Breed Championship show in Ireland. I have bred close to 50 champions. I have also co owned and shown an Irish Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier and I have owned and shown Papillons.

I am a BIS judge and passed to judge Groups 3, 9, 4, 7, and some breeds in Group 8.

I am Secretary of the Cairn Terrier Association of Ireland and I served on the IKC Judges Committee for a number of years. I am on the committee of the Irish Ladies Kennel Association.

I have judged in Ireland, Italy, France, Germany, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, England, Scotland, Wales, Czech Republic, Belgium, Holland, Croatia, Russia, Canada, and the USA.

KERIN AND RACHEL HUTCHINGS, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

I have been involved in the dog world since 1975, when I purchased my first Afghan Hound. Since then, and now along with my daughter Rachel, I have experienced much success with breeding and showing Afghan Hounds under the Suliman prefix. During this time, I have contributed to the development of our dogs, and the breed, by importing both dogs and semen to further enhance the Suliman Kennel.

Suliman has won two National Specialty BIS awards, four National specialty CC's, along with numerous Specialty BIS and many All Breed BIS awards at some of Australia's most prestigious and largest all breed shows. This includes twice winning BIS at Adelaide Royal, 8 Royal Best in Groups, and Puppy in Show at Sydney Royal.

Ten years ago, the Suliman Kennel also added Chinese Cresteds to the show team and we have also owned, shown and/or lived with Whippets, Beagles, a Standard Long Haired Dachshund and English Cocker Spaniel.

I became a Dogs Australia & FCI All Breeds Judge in 2018 and have been very honoured to have judged in Russia, Spain, USA, Canada, New Zealand, Thailand and all states of Australia. Prestigious judging appointments have included the well-known Monografica circuit in Spain, which included judging National Specialties for Afghans and Whippets and then overall BIS. I am very honoured to be invited to judge all sweepstakes at the 2026 Royal Melbourne Show in September.

My other contributions to the dog world include having served as a Councillor on the Dogs SA Board of Councillors, member of the Conformation Judges Training Scheme as the current Hound Group Leader and previously as Assistant Leader of the Toy Group. I also serve on the Disciplinary Panel for Dogs SA.

Thank you for your invitation to judge and I look forward to judging your beautiful dogs!

MICHAEL LEONARD, IRELAND

I have been involved in show dogs for the past 40 years. I grew up with dogs as my father had Gundogs on the family farm. The breeds that I have been involved in and made-up champions are: Old English Sheepdogs, Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, Bernese Mountain Dogs, Japanese Spitz and Tibetan Spaniels.

Under Irish Kennel Club rules and FCI, I am now qualified as an All Breed Judge. I am also a Best in Show Judge and have had this honour in Ireland, Denmark, Italy, France, Norway, Japan, Columbia, Malaysia, Sweden, South Africa, Hong Kong, Philippines, Thailand, Canada, Mexico, Indonesia, Brazil and China.

I have judged the Pup of the Year Competition in Ireland in 1997 and 2007, Dog of the Year in Denmark in 1998 and Show Dog of the Year in Sweden in 2001. Champion of Champions in Prague. In December 2016 I judged Champion of Champions in Estonia.

I have judged in most European countries and further afield in Argentina, America, Brazil, Canada, Australia, Japan, Columbia, New Zealand, Malaysia, South Africa, Hong Kong, China, Philippines, Mexico Indonesia and Thailand.

I have been involved in Show Dogs since 1977 when Michael Forte and I bought an Old English Sheepdog from Stella Harte. We quickly caught the show bug and within 2 years we were showing the Old English Sheepdog and Cavaliers. We set up the Kennel Prefix Leonfort and we quickly became known in Cavaliers as we won Best of Breed under Pamela Cross Stern with a ten-month-old puppy Ch Ronnoc Vincenzo at his first St Patricks Day Show (The Irish Crufts) in 1980. He won again the following year under Russell Roberts. Ch Ronnoc Vincenzo was the top stud dog in the breed for 6 years in a row. We made up 2 other Champions Ch Leonfort Vincenzo and Ch Vandyck Jester of Leonfort who both had wonderful show careers.

ARAMIS JOY LIM, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

I was born into the world of dogs, as my parents were both all-breed judges and breeders of German Shepherds, Boxers, Great Danes, Poodles, Mini Pins, and Dachshunds. From a very young age, I was involved in show handling these breeds.

I have been judging for over 30 years and have been very fortunate to have been invited to judge prestigious all-breed shows and specialty shows, including the Eukanuba World Challenge, World Dog shows, and FCI section shows in over 40 different countries worldwide. I have judged in many countries in Asia, Europe, Scandinavia, South and Central America, and the Caribbean. I have also judged shows in Israel, different states in Canada, and the United States of America.

Since moving to Australia in 1984, I have been involved in the breeding and very successful exhibiting of Shetland Sheepdogs with my wife, Pauline. Many of our Shelties have won Best in Show awards in both All Breeds and Specialty shows. We have also been involved with Miniature Schnauzers.

My current involvement with the South Australian Dog Community includes:

- Committee and life member of the All Breed Dog Club of South Australia.
- Judges Liaison Officer of the Dogs South Australia BlackHawk Winter International Show.
- Chairman of the Dogs South Australia Dog and Puppy of the Year show.
- Elected member of the Dogs South Australia Executive Council.
- Member and examiner with the judges training committee of South Australia.

PAULA NYKIEL, USA

Faye Strauss established Sherluck Dobermans in 1973 with her husband Gary. They have bred 100+ AKC Champions. As a handler, Faye finished numerous Dobermans and garnered many Best in Show and Group wins. She also handled other breeds.

Faye judges three Groups, and other breeds along with Best in Show and Junior Showmanship. She has judged many nationals, specialties, and Top 20's around the world. She was honoured to judge the Working Group at the Westminster Dog Show in 2022.

In 1995, Faye founded Sherluck MultiMedia that produced CD Breed Studies. Faye's book on 'The Doberman Pinscher' (TFH publisher) won Breed Book of the Year in 1998. 4.1 Class Structure (Age Requirements)

(a) PEE WEE

4 years of age up to 6 years of age. Optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

(b) JUNIOR NOVICE

For handlers 7 to 10 years who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

(c) JUNIOR OPEN

For handlers 7 to 10 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.

(d) INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

(e) INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.

(f) SENIOR NOVICE CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

(g) SENIOR OPEN CLASS

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

Entry Information

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries close 8 P.M. (ET) Wednesday, May 13, 2026, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.**
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

General Information

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Erie Shores Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Will be 30 feet from the rings and the official areas.

**Temporary
Competition
Number (TCN)**

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
- By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.

Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

**Event Registration
Number (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$64 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

**Non-Member
Participation Fee**

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170 plus applicable taxes.
 - b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
 - c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
 - d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

CH and Champion Points

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

**includes the dog awarded Winners*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

GCH and Grand Champion Points

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at group level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GCHEX and Grand Champion Excellent Points

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

Section 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Section 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

Altered Champion and Altered Points

Section 13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

**Conformation Show
Rules and Regulations**

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Section 4.7.1** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

**Moving Class Dog
to Specials Only**

Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

**NEW – Moving
Back to the Classes**

Section 8.10.5 A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.



HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.

OPEN CLASS – For all dogs.

FIELD CLASS – Dogs must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

VETERANS CLASS – For all dogs over 7 years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs compete for the regular placements, and the 1st-place dog and bitch will compete for Best of Breed. Veterans may be broken down into separate age categories. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

ALTERED – Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

SPECIALS ONLY – Dogs that are Canadian Champions.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

BABY PUPPY – A dog between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

STUD DOG & GET – Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BRACE – Two dogs shown by a single handler on one lead. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

TEAM – Four dogs of same breed (not necessarily same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

THREE GENERATION – Three consecutive generations (dog or bitch).

EXHIBITION ONLY – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in Regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular/Unofficial classes and/or Parades.

Limited Entry

OBEDIENCE: Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

RALLY: Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds

These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. *A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.*

Moving Up

6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

6.9.3 The Trial Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.

6.9.5 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

9.1 Class Structure (Age & Obedience Class Requirements)

(a) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

(b) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

(c) SENIOR OBEDIENCE PRE-NOVICE

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

(d) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

(e) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

(f) SENIOR OBEDIENCE NOVICE

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

(g) JUNIOR OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday.

(h) INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday.

(i) SENIOR OBEDIENCE OPEN

For handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday.

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the trial.

Any dog may be used at the Pre-Novice, or Novice level including those with any Obedience titles. A dog used at the Open level must have a CD title (either CKC and/or AKC).

Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler.

**Temporary
Competition
Number (TCN)**

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN), a PEN or a CCN number.

Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

**Event Registration
Number (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

**Performance Event
Number (PEN)**

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a **CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED** to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:

- The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (**not** on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List).
- The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- The dog must be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

**Canine Companion
Number (CCN)**

A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows **UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS** to compete in CKC performance events. To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:

Unrecognized Breeds

- The dog must be either an Unrecognized Breed.
- Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit an application online); or
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. **Master Obedience
Trial Champion
(MOTCH)**

Section 14.3.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 14.3.2 Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.

Section 14.3.3 Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits toward both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.

Section 14.3.4 One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.

Section 14.3.5 A dog must acquire a total of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.

**Rally Champion
(RCH)**

Section 16.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 16.2 A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.

Section 16.3 The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.

- (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
- (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
